A pre-bid meeting regarding Request for Bids issued for Upgradation and Rehabilitation of Institute of Meteorology & Geophysics (IMG) and Meteorological Workshop – Karachi was conducted at PMD Seismic Observatory Saidpur Office, Islamabad. The session was conducted as per provisions of the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" November 2020 facilitating both physical and online participation.

The session was commenced by the Deputy Project Director (MHSP) extending his warm welcome to all the participants along-with providing detailed guidelines to submit their bids. Regarding the Procurement process, it was apprised that the process will be single stage-two envelopes with rated criteria (20% scoring for technical part and 80% scoring for financial part). All the prospective bidders are required to read and comply with the requirements given in Request for Bids carefully to avoid any inconvenience.

The procurement process for this activity including submission procedures and evaluation criteria was explained to the participants in detail. It was apprised that there shall be two lots/contracts of this procurement activity. All the relevant forms/documents should be filled in accordance with the Request for Bids. The bids should reach this office by/before August 28, 2025 at 1100 hrs.

The following section outlines the queries raised by the prospective bidders, along with their corresponding responses:

The evaluation will be done lot by lot as well as for combinations of lots. If a bidder submits substantially responsive bids for both lots and achieves the best evaluated score (lowest evaluated cost and meets qualification criteria), he may be awarded both lots. However, if the bidder is not qualified for the combined requirements of both lots together, then contracts will be awarded separately for the lots, based on the highest evaluated score for which the bidder qualifies. |
