

Subject: COUNTRY-WIDE MILAD UL NABI ﷺ PROGRAM 1446 AH/2024AD

To pay tribute to the Holy Prophet Muhammad ﷺ and to disseminate his Seerah on the occasion of his Milad, a country-wide "Milad ul Nabi ﷺ Program" has been chalked out by the Ministry of Religious Affairs and Interfaith Harmony. This program shall be followed during the month of Rabi-ul-Awwal 1446AH/2024AD in the Federal capital and the provinces comprising the following activities:

1. **HOLDING OF NATIONAL REHMAT UL LIL ALMEEN CONFERENCE**

The Ministry of Religious Affairs and Interfaith Harmony will organize annual Seerat ul Nabi ﷺ Conference on 12th of Rabi-ul-Awwal, 1446 A.H at Islamabad on the following theme:

"ریات کا تسلیی نظام، سیرت النبی ﷺ کی روشنی میں"

The President and the Prime Minister of Pakistan will be the chief guests at the conference. Prominent religious scholars, dignitaries, political personalities and diplomats will attend the conference. Prize distribution ceremony will also be held wherein the outstanding position holders in the National Seerat/ Na'at Book/ Article competition will receive their prizes/awards.

2. **PROVINCIAL, DIVISIONAL & DISTRICT SEERAT CONFERENCES**

Seerat conferences at Provincial / Divisional and District headquarters, to be inaugurated by the Governors, the Ministers and eminent Ulema and Mashaikh, may be arranged. Provincial and District Seerat Committees may also be constituted for organizing Seerat Conferences. These Conferences shall consist of Naat Khawani, speeches by ulema on seerat topics particularly the topic of this year's International Seerat Conference mentioned above, seerat quiz etc.

3. **SEERAT WRITING COMPETITIONS**

To popularize the teachings of the Holy Prophet ﷺ and to project his model life, the Ministry of Religious Affairs and Interfaith Harmony conducts various Seerat competitions each year, such as:

- Seerat Books competition in national, regional and foreign languages
- Naat Books competition, in national, regional and foreign languages
- Islamic Books competition (female only)
- Maqalat-e-Seerat competition on a specific topic
- Journals/Magazines (issuing Special Seerat numbers) competition

Similar competitions may also be organized on the life and Seerah of the Holy Prophet ﷺ by Provincial Governments and educational institutions (schools, colleges and universities), as may be practicable within their budgetary provisions.

4. SEERAT MEETINGS/SEMINARS

Seerat meetings/seminars may be organized by our foreign missions, corporations, semi-Government organizations, autonomous bodies as well as by the Defence Establishment, so as to ensure the fullest possible participation of everyone in Rehmat ul Ili Almeen, ﷺ Celebrations. The official holiday, as usual, will be observed throughout the country on 12th Rabi-ul-Awwal. However, the heads of the educational institutions (schools, colleges and universities) will ensure the participation of students/teachers in the functions. They will also be responsible to hold functions in their institutions. Such functions shall consist of Naat Khawni, speeches on seerat topics particularly the topic of this year's National Seerat Conference, seerat quiz and shall conclude with prayers for prosperity, development of the country and welfare of the people of Pakistan.

5. PRESS, RADIO AND TV COVERAGE

As usual, maximum possible coverage and projection of the events through Mass Media (print, electronic and social media) throughout the month of Rabi-ul-Awwal will be ensured. Special Seerat editions by newspapers and magazines may be encouraged. Special naatia mushaira, Naat khawni and quiz programs on Seerat may be organized by TV and radio channels.

6. GENERAL

- a) 12th Rabi-ul-Awwal will be declared as a "Public Holiday". Seerat functions will be held in all educational institutions and public halls.
- b) 31 Guns Salute in the Federal Capital and will be fired at the dawn of the day on 12th Rabi-ul-Awwal.
- c) Special Seerat banners and illuminations on public buildings throughout the country will be arranged with due regard to Government's policy on an austerity drive.
- d) Charities may be arranged for orphanages, widows, destitute homes, disabled and handicapped persons and the concerned department may also arrange such activities in the prisons.
- e) The cinema houses and TV Centers etc. may show films and dramas on moral building themes and teachings of Holy Prophet ﷺ, instead of screening usual movies, during the month of Rabi ul Awwal.

NOTE

The expenditure on such celebrations/functions will be met by the respective ministries/divisions/departments/organizations from their own budgetary provisions.
